## **DORKING WANDERERS SET PATH FOR A NEW FUTURE FOR FOOTBALL AT PRESTIGIOUS LAUNCH**

DORKING WANDERERS are one of the founding members of Fair Game, a group of value-driven clubs, supported by 40 world-renowned experts and backed by politicians of all colours. The government is currently developing policies on how to change the national game as part of Tracey Crouch's football governance review. Fair Game aim is to help develop the long-term realistic solutions needed. The details of that vision are outlined in Fair Game's 48-page manifesto, Putting Pride Back In the Shirt: Fair Game's Solution for the National Game, which was launched today at Plough Lane, the home of AFC Wimbledon - one of the 23 clubs. It details solutions to various problems within football, including the owners and directors test, financial sustainability, protecting the heritage of clubs, a fairer distribution of TV revenues, opposing the European Super League, and tackling discrimination. The document is the result of over six months of hard-work from Fair Game, and follows: ongoing consultation with the clubs, recruitment of global experts, brainstorm, four workshops, nine expert-led working groups, a 66-page options documents, five surveys of clubs, and two open scrutiny sessions.

Marc White, Chairman, of Dorking Wanderers, said: "I am very pleased to be supporting this great campaign especially after the last two seasons that left many people wondering where we were going to end up. There definitely does need to be a shake up and a new direction forged at all levels of the game. Accountability and transparency are key to taking governance of our beautiful game to a much higher level"

# OPPOSITION FOREST ROW



**Founded:** 1892 **Nickname:** Frow **Ground:** Tinsley Lane

Frow are one of the oldest football clubs in Sussex, founded way back in 1892. The last 129 years has seen them play their trade in the Mid Sussex divisions, playing at the Memorial Ground nestled in the heart of the village. It's a beautiful sports pavilion that's still home to their Reserves, the Juniors and other sports including tennis and cricket.

After a new crop of players joined back in 2012, the club were fresh off the back of two successive demotions, managerless and languishing in the MSFL Division One. Fast forward 9 years and they are playing in the Southern Combination Football League for the first time in their existence.

Despite three promotions in this time, recent silverware has eluded Frow, coming close in the Montgomery Cup against Lindfield in 2016 and then reaching the Sussex Intermediate Cup final in 2020 only for COVID to enforce the cancellation of the competition. It was a

frustrating end to a successful season for Frow, who were also sitting pretty in second and going for the MSFL Prem title.

Following a groundshare agreement with Oakwood FC thanks to support from sponsors Elliot Scott Group, Frow's high placed finish at the end of the 2020/21 season was enough to take them up to County 1 and enjoy step 6 football. They also bid a fond farewell to the Mid Sussex Football League after all this time and can vouch for the high level of quality in the Prem.
